WAIVER/RELEASE OF LIABILITY

*PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING.
THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS.*

Waiver: In consideration of Participant's enrollment in a tennis program and/or Participant's use, today and on all future dates, of the property, facilities owned or operated by, and services of Planet Swim LLC (from hereon referred to as "Planet Swim"), Participant and Parent/Guardian, on behalf of Participant, Participant's heirs, personal representatives, or assigns, hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue, Planet Swim, its affiliated companies and each of its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, sponsors, independent contractors, and agents from liability from any and all claims arising from the negligence of Planet Swim or any of the aforementioned parties. This agreement applies to (1) personal injury (including death) from accidents, injuries or illnesses arising from participation in various activities including, but not limited to, participation in sport programs, travel, competition, educational classes, lessons, social activity, and individual use of facilities, premises, or equipment; and (2) any and all claims resulting from the damage to, loss of, or theft of property. Trespassing is not permitted into the property.

Indemnification and Hold Harmless: Participant and Parent/Guardian also agree to HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY Planet Swim from all claims resulting from all negligence of Planet Swim and to reimburse Planet Swim for any expenses incurred as a result of Participant's participation in a tennis program and presence at Planet Swim facilities. Participant and Parent/Guardian further agree to pay all costs and attorneys' fees incurred by Planet Swim in investigating and defending a claim or suit but only if Participant's claim is withdrawn to the extent an arbitrator determines that Planet Swim is not responsible for the injury or loss. Participant and Parent/Guardian agree to hold harmless and indemnify Planet Swim from all claims and amounts related to legal and other action brought against Planet Swim for damages caused by Participant (for example, for damages caused by Participant while fighting with another participant).

Severability and Venue: Participant and Parent/Guardian further expressly agree that this waiver is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of Florida and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the remaining portion of the waiver will continue in full legal force and effect.

Acknowledgment of Understanding: Participant and Parent/Guardian have read this waiver and fully understand its terms. Participant and Parent/Guardian understand that Participant is giving up rights, including the right to compensation for injury resulting from negligence of Planet Swim. Participant and Parent/Guardian acknowledge that they are signing the agreement freely and voluntarily and intend their signature to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law. In signing this waiver as parent or guardian, I acknowledge that I am consenting to Participant's participation in a tennis program at Planet Swim and acknowledge that I understand that any and all risks, including that of negligence, whether known or unknown are expressly assumed by Participant and Parent/Guardian and all claims, whether known or unknown, are expressly waived in advance.

TO PARTICIPATE

Assumption of Risks: Physical activity, by its very nature, carries with certain dangers and risks that cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid injuries. Planet Swim has programs for swimming and tennis and related activities such as strength training. Some of these activities involve strenuous exertions of strength using various muscle groups, some involve quick movements involving speed and change of direction, some involve contact with equipment, other participants and various surfaces, and others involve sustained physical activity which places stress on the cardiovascular system. Participant will also be exposed to risks while traveling and participating in various activities. Some of these activities involve travel in vehicles (for example, in vans when traveling to a competition or to the airport) and exposure to large crowds. These specific risks vary from one activity to another, but in each activity the risks range from (1) minor injuries such as scratches, cuts, bruises, and sprains to (2) major injuries such as loss of sight, loss of teeth, broken bones, joint or back injuries, concussions, and heart attacks to (3) catastrophic injuries including paralysis and death. I also understand that the Participant may expose others, or may be exposed, to contagious diseases such as COVID-19, influenza, chickenpox, measles, etc. Participant and Parent/Guardian have read the previous paragraphs and (1) understand the nature of the activities at Planet Swim, (2) understand the demands of those activities relative to the physical condition and skill level of Participant, and (3) understand the types of illnesses and injuries which may occur as a result of activities made possible by Planet Swim. Participant and Parent/Guardian hereby assert that participation is voluntary, and that Participant and Parent/Guardian knowingly assume all such risks.

Acknowledgment of Rules and Standards of Conduct: I understand that Planet Swim has rules and standards of conduct that are set forth in the Member Handbook and/or instructed by the Management team. I agree to abide by these rules and standards for the safety of Participants, the Team Member, and the other participants.

Acknowledgment of Understanding: Participant and Parent/Guardian have read this agreement to participate and fully understand its terms. Participant and Parent/Guardian acknowledge freely and voluntarily signing the agreement and intend the signature to signify a complete assumption of the inherent risks of participating in or observing activities at Planet Swim to the greatest extent allowed by law in the state of Florida. In signing this assumption of risk as Parent/Guardian, I acknowledge that I am consenting to the participant's participation at Arrowhead (as specified in paragraph one) and acknowledge that Participant and Parent/Guardian expressly assume all inherent risks of the all activities at Arrowhead.

COVID-19 Policy & Checklist

To protect our staff and our customers, we kindly ask that you answer the following questions prior coming to Planet Swim Tennis Club:

1. Have you or other member of your household travel to any high-risk areas in the past 14 days?
2. Have you or other member of your household had contact with a suspected or confirmed case of someone having COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
3. Have you or anyone in your family currently have flu-like symptoms or other symptoms that could indicate COVID-19?

IF YOU ANSWERED "YES" TO ANY OF THE ABOVE QUESTIONS, PLEASE DO NOT COME TO THE CLUB AND CONTACT OUR OFFICE IMMEDIATELY!

Policies *Effective as of September 2022*

Disclaimer: All players wishing to join the Planet Swim Tennis Club (PSTC) junior program must have a parent or legal guardian sign the disclaimer and fill out the contact information form before the starting date.

Communication: Updates on program changes, cancellations and news will be communicated through email and Court Reserve. Please provide in a legible manner all email addresses you wish to be included for PSTC communications while filling out your registration form.

Billing, Refunds and Withdrawal: Payments for the month are due on the 1st of each month to reserve your spot.

- You can login to your Player Portal (via Court Reserve) and update your payment information.
- There no refunds for any reason.
- Should you wish to withdraw from your clinics prior to the end of the month, a credit will be placed onto your tennis account in the value of the remaining lessons.
- If at any point you wish to discontinue your enrollment for the upcoming month, please send us an email to billing@planetswim.org requesting a hold on your account BEFORE the 27th of the month.
- If you fail to notify us before the 27th of the month and your account has already been charged, all we will be able to do is credit the full amount onto your tennis account. Class credit can be used at any time within a one-year period.

Make-ups & Cancellations:

- If your child is unable to attend a clinic, please call or email us at your earliest convenience so we are ware of any scheduling changes! Due to high demand and limited availability, last minute cancellations (less than 4 hours notice prior to the class) will NOT be eligible for a make-up lesson.
- Make-up Eligibility for Absences:
 - 1 time a week enrollment allows ONE make-up per month
 - 2 times a week enrollment allows TWO make-ups per month
 - 3 times a week enrollment allows THREE make-ups per month
 - 4 times a week enrollment allows FOUR make-ups per month
- Please understand we cannot control the weather and at times it can be very unpredictable, however, we always do our best to make an educated decision and notify you in a timely manner. In case of inclement weather, our staff will contact the parents via email to cancel the lessons about 20 - 30 minutes in advance. Please make sure you have our emails registered/verified so that the notifications do not end up in your spam folder.
 - All weather cancellations will be made up or credited back to your account.
 - If a clinic gets interrupted by the weather and we're able to accomplish at least 50% of the clinic, this does not count as a weather cancellation.
- Parents are responsible for scheduling make-up lessons due to both absences & cancellations. To schedule your make-up lesson please stop by or reach out to the Front Desk Staff.
- Make-ups will expire at the end of the month and WILL NOT roll over to the next month unless scheduled otherwise with our staff.
- There will be NO make-up lessons for a missed make-up.
- Make-up schedule depends on our current availability and please understand that in order to make this as smooth as possible we depend on being notified of any absences so we can then offer your spot to someone in need of a make-up lesson.

5th Week Enrollment: Your tuition is a based on a monthly fee for 4; 8; 12; or 16 clinics per month with certain months having 5 weeks. These 5th weeks/days will be used exclusively for make-up lessons to ensure we can accommodate the amount of make-ups that accumulate due to absences or rain outs.

- If you are in need of a make-up lesson please contact our Front Desk Staff to get it scheduled.
- If your regular clinic day falls on the same day as 5th day, please don't automatically assume that you will automatically have a spot for a make-up class on the extra week but always check with the Front Desk for make-up availability.
- If you complete your prepaid number of clinics before the month is over, you will NOT have a clinic in the 5th week. You can either restart your enrollment again the following month at your regular time, or schedule a drop-in clinic at a cost equivalent to one clinic (this option is only available if spots are open, as make-ups will have a priority to be scheduled first, please check at the Front Desk if you would like to add an extra lesson).

Clinic/Group Placement and Movement: Players will be placed in clinic groups according to age and skill level. Players may not attend group clinics or training sessions outside of their age and skill level unless approved by PSTC staff. Movement from group to group can happen in two ways. When a player's age exceeds the age limit for that group, they "age out" and will be moved to the next age-appropriate group. When a player improves enough to warrant participation in a more challenging group, that player will "skill out" and be moved to higher level group. Movement from group to group must be approved by PSTC staff.

Racquet Stringing: All racquet stringing is done in-house .All Racquet Stringing Invoices are paid at the time of drop-off, payable to Planet Swim LLC. Please note, frames are inspected for damage when they are handed in, we cannot string the racquet if the frame is cracked or broken. Should frame damage occur as a result of normal stringing procedure, we cannot be held responsible. Although we try our best to have racquets ready within a 3-day turn around, some orders may require a longer turn around time.

Observation/Viewing Policy: We kindly ask parents, siblings and visitors to stay off the court area during lessons. Lessons can be observed from outside of the fence or from the bleachers. Parents/Caretakers/Observers are not to talk to their children while in class unless necessary.

Alcohol Policy: Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages permitted on the premises unless an adult social event is being held by the club

Junior Program Code of Conduct

Dress Code

Junior players are expected to dress appropriately when using the tennis courts. The following clothing is not permitted:

- T shirts with offensive language or images
- Sleeveless shirts not specifically made for tennis
- Bathing suits or sports bras
- Cut-off shorts or jeans
- Shoes other than tennis shoes

Conduct on the Court

Junior members 14 and older may book court time for casual play. All junior players under 14 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. No food or gum will be allowed on the court. Players will not walk across another court while play is occurring. Immediately following play, players will brush and line the court for the next court booking unless it is closing time. Players will use the shoe washers before leaving the court.

Conduct During Lessons

PSTC junior program participants are expected to be courteous to their peers and coaches at all times. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary action including running laps, short "time out", or extra ball pick-ups. Some of these behaviors include the following:

- Foul or offensive language including jokes
- Throwing or hitting balls at other players
- Making fun of other players
- "Launching" balls over the fence on purpose

The safety and well-being of our players is our highest priority. The following behaviors are

considered dangerous and detrimental to the PSTC junior program and may require more severe disciplinary action including suspension for the day from the clinic or expulsion from the PSTC junior program permanently:

- Racket Throwing
- Incessant Cursing
- Taunting or harassing other players
- Inappropriate or violent physical contact
